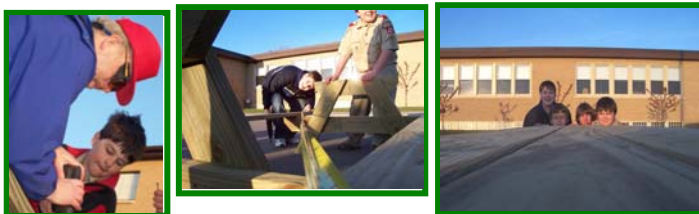




May 2nd, 2005, Picnic Tables for Camp Phillips

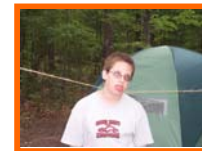
Summer Camp – July 3rd through July 9th

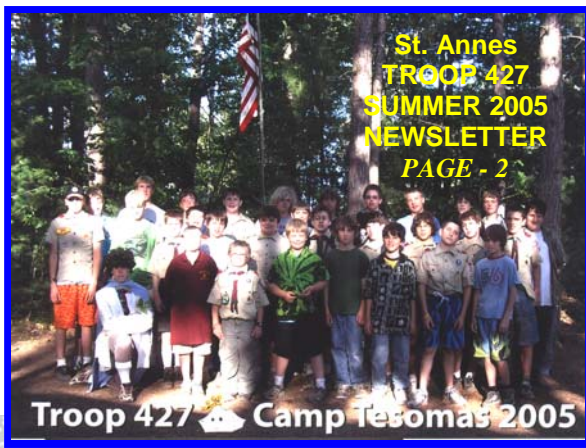
